Notice Is Hereby Given that the District Council has received applications for planning permission, Listed Building Consent, a Departure, Major Development, Significant Development, or which may affect a Public Right of Way, as the case may be, for developments as briefly described in the following schedule.

MO/2019/1431/CC: 26, High Street, Leatherhead: Removal of Condition 5 of approved Planning Permission MO/2013/1020 for alterations to existing ground floor retail unit. Erection of part first floor, part first and second floor extension at rear and conversion of ground floor to allow creation of 9 No residential units with additional new access off Kings Head Alley as no increased rate or volume of surface water runoff was produced by the development. **MO/2019/1446/PLA & 1447/LBC: 19, High Street, Bookham, Leatherhead:** Partial conversion of a shop and the associated storage area into 1 No. bedroom flat and 1 No. studio flat. To include the installation of new windows and doors, and small flat roof porch and new lantern to the existing flat roof. **MO/2019/1519/PLA: 17B, Vincent Road, Dorking:** Erection of pair of semi-detached houses on Vincent Road and pair of semi-detached houses on land to the rear following demolition of existing workshop. **MO/2019/1526/PLAH: 13, The Borough, Brockham, Betchworth:** Erection of single storey rear extension. **MO/2019/1529/LBC: 12, Church Road, Bookham:** Erection of replacement porch.
