Terms and Conditions - Good Causes



We encourage as many organisations as possible to join the Mole Valley Community Lottery as one of the eligible good causes. As you will be joining under our overall gambling licence (Gambling Act 2005), we have to ensure that organisations meet certain criteria. There is no application fee.

Your organisation must:

- Provide community activities or services within the district which benefit Mole Valley residents
- Have a constitution
- Have a bank account
- Operate with no undue restrictions on membership

Be either:

- A registered charity, with a board of trustees; or
- A registered Community Interest Company; or
- Any other constituted group with a volunteer management committee comprising at least three members and which meets at least three times a year

We will not permit applications from:

- Groups promoting campaigns that do not directly relate to the provision of community activities or services within Mole Valley
- Organisations that do not do work within the districts boundaries
- Individuals
- Organisations which aim to distribute a profit
- Organisations with no established management committee/board of trustees (unless a CIC)

We are also unable to accept applications that are incomplete.

Mole Valley District Council reserves the right to:

- Reject any application for any reason; and
- Terminate the participation of any organisation with a minimum of seven days' notice for any reason, unless fraudulent, reputational damaging or illegal activity is suspected in which case termination will be immediate
