



District Council Elections - 3 May 2018

Make sure you are registered to vote for elections taking place in 2018.

There will be District Council Elections in certain parts of the district on Thursday 3 May 2018. Further information about the Wards up for election can be found online at www.molevalley.gov.uk

If you want to have your say at these elections, you must be registered to vote. You can register online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote. If you are registered, you will receive a Poll Card in late March/early April which will confirm information about the election and how to cast your vote.

If you do not receive a Poll Card and are unsure whether you are registered, please contact the Elections Team using the details overleaf.

If you can't get to a polling station on 3rd May, find out how to apply for an absent vote overleaf.



DON'T LOSE YOUR RIGHT TO VOTE

Can't make it to your polling station on 3rd May 2018?



You can apply to vote by post or you can appoint someone to vote on your behalf (by proxy).

The person you have appointed to vote on your behalf can also vote by post for you (postal proxy).

In order to vote in one of these ways, you will need to complete an “absent vote” form which can be downloaded from our website at www.molevalley.gov.uk or by visiting www.yourvotematters.co.uk. You can only vote by post or by proxy if your registration has been confirmed.

Deadline for receiving:

Applications for registration*	Tuesday 17 April 2018
New postal vote and postal proxy applications, and for changes to existing postal or proxy votes	5pm on Wednesday 18 April 2018
New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy– see above)	5pm on Wednesday 25 April 2018

*Early registration is advised if you intend to vote by post to ensure that you receive your Postal Pack in good time.

The sooner you apply to register the better.

Please note that paying Council Tax does not automatically add your details to the Electoral Register.
